Guide for Household waste

Biowaste

Only biodegradable wastes:

Biowaste is decomposing and compostable food and kitchen waste, also easily decomposed fibrous materials

Attn! Pack biowaste.



Mixed Waste

No hazardous waste, no waste electrician and electronic equipment

Plastic products, dirty packages, dirty carton, ash, worn-out clothing and shoes



Plastic Packages

Remove caps and lids

Clean and dry plastic packages: plastic containers, wrappers, bag or bottles used for packaging products to be sold

Attn! Plastic products, dirty packages and PVC are mixed waste.



Glass

Coloured and clear glass bottles and jars only

Attn! Drinking-, mirror-, window glasses and porcelain are mixed waste.



Carton

Rinse dirty cartons and flatten them out

Clean and dry carton/cardboard: packages, paper bags, toilet and paper towel rolls, milk and juice cartons.

Attn! Remember to flatten the packages.



Paper

All postal mail you receive:

newspapers and magazines, adverts, brochures, envelopes, phone books and product catalogues, books (hardcover books with the covers removed), copy paper and printouts, white drawing and notepad paper and white paper bags

NO wet or dirty paper



Metal

Metal cans and small metal items:

food cans and aluminium tins, empty paint buckets, steak pans etc.



Large batches of waste, cleaning loads, hazardous waste and electrical equipment are received sorted at the waste stations of the waste management service.

- **medicinal products** to pharmacies
- **batteries** to stores
- **other hazardous waste** to the collection container or Sortti station
